

## NATIONAL DISASTER MANAGEMENT

National Disaster Management Authority abbreviated as NDMA is an agency of the Ministry of Home Affairs whose Primary purpose is to coordinate response to natural or man- made disasters and for the capacity building in disaster resiliency and crisis response.

NDMA was established through the Disaster Management act enacted by the government of India in Dec. 2005.
